



MEMORANDUM FOR INTERCHANGE OF STUDENTS BETWEEN TOHOKU MEDICAL AND PHARMACEUTICAL UNIVERSITY AND NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA

In order to promote mutual understanding and friendship, to enhance educational opportunities for their students, Tohoku Medical and Pharmaceutical University and National University of Mongolia hereupon consent that the following Memorandum for student interchange be attached to the "Agreement of Academic Interchange and Educational Cooperation."

- 1. Interchange students may study at the host university for a maximum of one year. The interchange activity will be taken in the form of collaboration for research or completion of electives.
- 2. Each university will determine its own method of selecting students for the interchange programs and recommend students who are considered appropriate. However, it is the host university that will determine whether the recommended students are admissible and the number of students that will be admitted.
- 3. The interchange students will be entitled to the same privileges and be subject to the same rules and regulations as other students at the host university.
- 4. Completed applications from each student must be submitted to the host university at least three months before the beginning of the interchange activity.
- 5. The host university will waive charges for admission, tuition and facilities for the students concerned. Except for these charges, all expenses (including travel fares and accommodation costs) shall be borne by the students individually.
- 6. Before departing from their home countries, the interchange students are required to purchase health insurance, which is valid in the country in which they will be studying. All students must possess passports and visas valid for the period of the interchange.
- 7. Each university will accept credits earned by the interchange students as part of the credits necessary for graduation.

- 8. This memorandum shall come into effect from the date of signing by the representatives of both universities. The memorandum may be abrogated by mutual consent or six months after written notice is given by either university.
- 9. This memorandum is to be executed in two original documents, both written in English and being equally authentic.
