**Chia Nan University of Pharmacy and Science, Taiwan**

This Memorandum is made effective on December 21, 2011


Tohoku Pharmaceutical University (TPU), Japan and Chia Nan University of Pharmacy and Science (CNU), Republic of China (Taiwan), hereafter referred to the Schools, agree to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to become partner/sister schools to build up friendship and cooperation between school communities and promote mutual understanding between TPU and CNU in the areas of education, research, and services.

The Schools have reached the following understanding:

- I. The Schools will promote the academic activities, including :  
exchange of faculty members, exchange of students, joint research projects, joint conferences, and joint cultural programs.
- II. The Schools agree that this MOU is endorsed without any legally enforceable rights, which may be used to benefit either party.
- III. The Schools acknowledge that this MOU shall remain in force over a period of five years from the effective date above, and upon mutual written agreement, it shall be renewed after five years. Any amendment or modification to this MOU is subject to mutual consent.
- IV. Termination of this MOU should be made by the Schools with a written notice six months prior to its expiration date.
